



In addition to focused outreach & small group activity, we made use of some friendly partnerships with neighboring ministries to bring the gospel in unique ways to our worship services. We invited a substance abuse ministry, Teen Challenge, and the Miracle Voices choir to minister via song and personal testimony. The men from TC were a great encouragement to many in our congregation, who have family members who wrestle with substance abuse. Hearing the damage that drugs/alcohol had on their lives and the gospel beginning to set them free was reaffirming that the Gospel does change us. Our second guest's, MVC, brought their booming and God-centered voices to lift up the hearts of our many visitors. Their ministry has inspired some in our congregation to pray for the Lord to raise up a youth choir for our church. Both of these events served as great incentive to invite neighbors and friends to church. We saw our largest attendances in the history of our church.

In the midst of our missional focus, we are also focusing and witnessing genuine lifechange. We are preparing to have 4-6 folks examined for membership. As well, we had 3 new leaders examined to be teachers within the church, while 3 men will also begin the 2 year elder candidacy process after the first of the year. Without a doubt, our leadership base has grown and matured over the past 3 1/2 years.
